Approval of Minutes - Minutes from the April 12, 2012, meeting were reviewed for approval. Amendments are:

1. Change "Investigators" in the committee title to "Investigation"
2. Under ORC 4947.03 License Requirement, change sentence to "Unarmed security officers and private investigators will be registered based on rule making concerning felony and misdemeanor convictions."
3. Add a \$ to 150.00
4. Under ORC 4749.09 Effect of municipal regulations, change sentence to "Regulate at the state level pre-empted by state regulations."

Old Business-

Review and Changes of Legislative Committee Discussion Draft-Points of discussion were:

ORC 4749.10 Carrying firearms-

The OPISSC Training Committee decided to eliminate OPOTA, and have Department of Public Safety orchestrate firearms training and certify. The Training committee wants to bring OPOTA certified instructors from the industry to conduct training, as well as OPOTA's 20 hour class and curriculum. Public Safety will be responsible for the curriculum.

ORC4749.09 Effect of municipal regulation-fees-

Municipalities will be pre-empted at the state level by state regulations.

ORC 4749.03 License requirement-

Business names that have been revoked have to wait a year before names can be used again.

ORC 4749.11 Investigating applicants-

ORC 4749.12 Nonresident licenses-

Temporary non-resident license exemption as long as the non-resident is holding a valid license from another state.

ORC 4749.99 Penalty-
